Gary Moye has been a licensed, practicing Architect since 1972. His extensive experience with building design and its processes encompasses a broad range of building types and project contexts and includes both new and remodel work in Eugene, Portland, Seattle, Philadelphia and The District of Columbia. Mr. Moye has also been a professor of Architecture at the University of Oregon for the past thirty-three years.

Gary studied in the Masters Studio of world-renowned architect Louis I. Kahn at the University of Pennsylvania and for seven years afterwards was a member of Kahn's architectural firm in Philadelphia. During the course of his work with Mr. Kahn he assisted in the design and production phases for most of the projects undertaken from 1967 until Kahn's death in 1974. Following Kahn's death, Gary was a partner in the successor firm formed to complete the work then in progress. He was partner-in-charge and project designer of the Hill Central Middle School, the Pocono Arts Center, and of the Music Barge for the American Wind Symphony Orchestra of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

From 1978 to 1985, Gary worked with Portland based BOOR/A Architects on a selective project basis. His work with BOOR/A included serving as the lead designer for: The Alaska Legislative Hall Competition; the Arts and Sciences Faculty Office Building at Seattle University; The Itogumi Country Club and Golf Course in Chitose Japan; and the Fine Arts center at Pacific University in Forest Grove, Oregon.

Gary Moye established his Eugene office in 1986 and since that time has been involved in a variety of interiors, architecture, and planning projects, including commercial, institutional, ecclesiastical, recreational, academic, and residential work. The firm also provides planning and project definition services for small communities, civic groups, institutional, and academic clients.
